2 rule changes for 2018 made at the CTCPA AGM held on Nov 18, 2017.

- Team Cattle Penning Classes
  - **Each association must use the current 4 sanctioned classes (Open or 12 class, #10 class, #7 class, #5 class) but has the option to change one of those above classes for a one year period only.**
  - ATCPS members voted in favor to keep the ATCPS class structure as status quo for 2018.
- Order of Go
  - **In the event of a third or fourth go, the team must pen to advance**
  - Not directly applicable to the current ATCPS Show Format for 2018

2018 ATCPS Show Format Changes:

Number of shows to qualify for the September Sunday jackpot changed to 6 shows from 5 shows.

The number of rides per class in the 10 and 7 class will decrease from 5 to 4 rides (including the draw). The open and Ltd 11 classes will remain unlimited. The 5 class will remain at 5 rides (including the draw). The Senior and Junior Youth classes remain at 3 rides (2 picks and 1 draw team).

Year-end points will be calculated for both team and individual after the second go only. 0.5 points are given for every team you beat and bonus points are awarded to the top 5 teams.

Implementation of a Voluntary Bingo rule to speed up classes/the day and save on cattle energy will apply to all classes except the Senior & Junior Youth and 5 Class.

Items that will remain status quo:

- A rider is allowed to ride 2 rides in the 10, 7 and 5 Class before you are required to ride a mandatory draw team.
- Classes offered will remain with Open, Ltd 11, Ten, Senior & Junior Youth, Seven and Five.
- Individual Points are calculated on the top 4 placings in the 10 & 7 Classes, the top 5 placings in the Open and 5 Classes and the top 3 placings in the Youth Classes.
- No sub rule. Medical subs only allowed by board approval if rider injured at a show.
- The rider change out rule remains at 1 rider per team in all classes.
- No draw required in the open
